EDUCATORS, PARENTS, STUDENTS HOST SCHOOL SAFETY FORUM

HARRISBURG (April 16, 2018) - On the eve of the 19th anniversary of the school shooting at Columbine High School, members of organizations representing families, educators, school administrators, school boards, and law enforcement will join parents, students, and Pennsylvania Attorney General Josh Shapiro for a town hall meeting on school safety issues on April 19 at Susquehanna Township High School.

WHAT: Town hall meeting on school safety

WHO: Hosted by PSEA, PASA, PSBA, PA Principals, PA PTA, and Attorney General Josh Shapiro; representatives from these organizations will be on stage, along with a school psychologist and a safety officer

WHEN: April 19; 6 p.m. – 8 p.m.

WHY: Parents of more than 1 million students send their children to Pennsylvania's public schools every day, and those students count on the people in the host organizations to do our best to provide them safe spaces to learn.

This town hall meeting will provide a forum for professionals, students, and parents to share ideas for how to strengthen school safety, beginning a public dialogue about solving existing challenges and demonstrating that this is a responsibility of the whole community.
